Description	<p>Boughton House in Northamptonshire has been home to the Buccleuch family for over 450 years. Known as the English Versailles, the estate was purchased by Edward Montague in 1528. The former monastery was further extended and developed until 1690.</p> <p><i>Barton Plant will be involved in subsequent phases after this success</i></p> <p>Barton Plant was contracted to restore the grounds back to the 17th century design. This involved the de-silting of the waterways, lakes and lily ponds. Barton Plant worked closely with the estate gardeners to ensure all works were sympathetically undertaken.</p> <p>Such was the success of this project, that Barton Plant will be involved in subsequent phases. These will include the restoration of the original mound and ha-ha and the construction of the modern mound. This to be built directly opposite the original mound to provide a contrast.</p>
